<b>Specific objectives /statements and procedures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Early Years providers within the children's centre reach area will seek parents' permission to share assessment information about their child's progress towards the Early Learning goals.</li> <li>• This permission will be obtained either by the EY provider's own registration forms or using a separate permission form.</li> <li>• By providing permission the family will be automatically registered with their Children's Centre for membership purposes only.
