

Specific objectives /statements and procedures	Early Years providers within the children's centre reach area will seek parents' permission to share assessment information about their child's progress towards the Early Learning goals.  This permission will be obtained either by the EY provider's own registration forms or using a separate permission form.  By providing permission the family will be automatically registered with their Children's Centre for membership purposes only. This will give the family access to the Children's Centre's services which are now part of Children's and Families Service - Prevention  The EY provider will share the summative assessments for the early years children in their care with the children's centre using an EYFS tracker summary at the following times:  On entry/starting assessment Vulnerability Conversations 2 year-old assessment check last assessment before starting another provision (school or nursery)  The children's centre will use this information to track children's progress and contribute to the continuous planning of Prevention services.
